


#### Student exchange abroad

- Diak degree students can complete a part of their degree abroad in student exchange programmes
- You can study or complete a work placement abroad
- Timing of the student exchange
  - The recommended timing varies between different degree programmes
  - Discuss the timing of your exchange with your study guidance counselor, check our website for recommendations
  - Typically Diak students go for student exchange in their 3rd year
  - A minimum 60 credits completed before going on exchange
- Application one year before the planned exchange, second application round one semester before



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#### **Duration of the exchange**



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
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## Student exchange types



#### Studying in a university abroad





- Studying as an exchange student in a university abroad is a good opportunity to develop international networks, learn about cultures and get a new perspectives.
- Diak students can only go for student exchange to Diak partner universities.
- The agreement defines how many students Diak can annually send to each university.
- If there are more applicants than places, the selection criteria is gpa.
- Exchange students do not pay tuition fees in the destination university.
- Some partner universities also offer work placements. It is possible to combine work placement and studies.

#### Work placement in Europe

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- Finding a work placement organisation
  - Diak has partner organisations in some European countries. The working language is English; Finnish or the local language.
    - Nursing: hospitals and health centres
    - Social services: Finnish seamen's mission, Finnish schools and children's homes
  - Some of our partner universities arrange work placements in the area. The working language is English or the local language.
  - In Europe you can also look for and arrange work placements yourself.
    - Check the placement goals and contents of your degree programme carefully
    - Contact interesting organisations that might provide tasks that are suitable for the placement
    - Check the suitability of the organisation with the international academic supervisor of your field of study

#### Work placement outside the EU

- Finding a work placement organisation
  - Diak has partner organisations in Asia and Africa
  - You can look for and arrange placements yourself outside Europe only in special cases: you have lived in the area, you have family or other support network in the area, you know the area well. Diak will evaluate the safety and suitability of the destination.


Same grant for all, independent of the length of the exchange (1500€/ exchange)

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





#### Funding

- All accepted students will receive a grant for the exchange
- European destinations Erasmus grant 500-700 €/month + travel support
- Diak partner organisations outside EU Erasmus grant 700 €/month + travel support
- Work placement in another organisation outside EU Free mover grant 1500 €/exchange
- Kela student allowance, study loan and housing support are available for eligible students also during student exchange
- If you receive some other support in Finland, please consult the authority providing the support

#### Funding

• All Erasmus+ mobilities include travel support based on the distance to the destination

#### **Insurance & safety**

- Diak provides a traveller's health insurance for all exchange students
- The insurance does not cover luggage or personal belongings
- EU citizens going to European destinations must get a European health insurance card
- All students (including non-Finnish citizens) must notify the local Finnish embassy about their stay in the area. For instructions and forms, see formin.fi.
- Falcony system in use during the exchange
